- ◆ Provide policy makers with accurate information and promote understanding of the beneficial impacts of the school Medicaid programs;
- ◆ Work with educational, child advocacy, and allied health organizations to promote health outcomes that can be wholly or partially achieved via school Medicaid programs;
- ◆ Serve as a national clearinghouse for information, tools, and resources that support effective use of school Medicaid programs;
- ◆ Foster a network for direct information exchange and dialogue among LEAs regarding best practices and effective state programs participating in school Medicaid programs;
- ◆ Provide various forums for regular communication among school Medicaid program stakeholders; and,
- ◆ Advocate for funding of effective school Medicaid programs and practices.

LEAnet MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Organizational Membership:

Member organizations are public or non-profit entities which share LEAnet objectives. Each member organization designates a voting representative who will serve on LEAnet Council. The organizations designated voting representative has the right to vote on all issues before the membership, elect officers and board members, hold office, and serve as chair of a standing or special committee.

- ◆ Local Education Agency Annual Membership Fee:
 - Small (fewer than 1000 enrolled students): \$100/organization
 - Medium (1001 to 5000 enrolled students): \$250/organization
 - Large (more than 5001 enrolled students): \$500/organization
- ◆ Other Public or Non-Profit Entities Membership Fee: \$500

Sponsor Membership:

Any individual or organization that shares LEAnet objectives. Each such individual/organization will choose a representative who will serve as the organization's non-voting member of the LEAnet Council. A Sponsor's representative has the right to attend all LEAnet council meetings, membership meetings, participate in activities of the organization, serve on standing and special committees. Gold and Platinum Sponsors shall also receive individual updates on LEAnet activities, including political action.

- ◆ Sponsor Annual Membership Fee:
 - Silver: \$2500
 - Gold: \$5000
 - Platinum: \$5000+

Individual Membership:

Individual members may be persons from the private or public sector who share LEAnet objectives. Individual Members have the right to attend all membership meetings and participate in activities of the organization, serve on standing and special committees. Individual members may not be members of the LEAnet Council, vote or hold office.
